**Notice Regarding 2020 1095-B Health Coverage Information Forms**

The Form 1095-B is an annual report that identifies which months you and your dependents were enrolled in "minimum essential coverage." In the past, the United Food and Commercial Workers Unions and Employers Health and Welfare Fund – Atlanta (“Fund”) provided you a copy of this Form in order to confirm that Fund coverage meets the requirement of minimum essential standards of coverage set by the Affordable Care Act. The Internal Revenue Service (IRS) announced that for the 2020 coverage year (as it did last year for the 2019 coverage year) funds do not have to mail Form 1095-B this year because there is no longer a penalty associated with not having minimum essential coverage under federal law. Accordingly, you will not receive a copy of the Form 1095-B in the mail, but the Fund will provide a copy to you if you request it. A copy of this form will be provided to you within 30 days of your request.
