



Due to recent limited availability of biometric screening appointments, the Wellness Program requirements have been changed for 2021.

You will qualify for the lowest employee co-premium levels for your 2022 coverage if you have a biometric screening that was completed in either 2019, 2020 or 2021.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR 2021 WELLNESS PROGRAM

Your Health & Welfare Fund encourages you to stay engaged in your health through the annual biometric screening campaign. However, we realize that access to screening appointments at pharmacy and The Little Clinic locations has been limited this year. Therefore, **for this year only**, your wellness program screening requirement will be considered satisfied if you had a screening reported to the Fund in 2019 or 2020, **or** if you complete a screening during this year and submit the results to the Fund Office by **December 31, 2021 (deadline has been extended)**.

If you obtain your screening at the Kroger Pharmacy or the Little Clinic and identified yourself as a Kroger employee, your screening status will automatically be reported to the Fund. If you obtain a screening through another provider, you are responsible for returning the completed screening form.
